Formal and structural requirements for abstracts

Abstracts should be submitted **by 23 October 2026** at the latest to the following e-mail address: resperger.richard@uni-sopron.hu

Formal requirements:

1. Before submission, the abstract must be checked by the author(s) for spelling, grammar and language accuracy.
2. The abstract must be prepared in **Microsoft Word** format, using **12 pt Times New Roman** font, justified alignment and single line spacing. **Margins** must be **2.5 cm** on all sides.
3. The **main text** of the abstract must be at least 150 words, approximately 12 lines, and no more than 200 words, approximately 16 lines.

Structural and content requirements:

1. **The title of the abstract** must be provided in the language of the oral presentation/poster. In the case of presentations/posters in Hungarian or German, the title must also be provided in English.
2. **Author information** must include:
 - title and name;
 - position and institutional affiliation; in the case of presentations/posters in Hungarian or German, this information must also be provided in English;
 - e-mail address of the author(s), indicating the corresponding author in the case of multiple authors.
3. **The main text of the abstract** *must include the objectives, methods, main results, and conclusions.*
In the case of presentations/poster in Hungarian or German, the text of the abstract must also be submitted in English. Ensure the English abstract is a linguistically correct translation of the Hungarian or German abstract.
4. **Keywords:** maximum 5; in the case of presentations/posters in Hungarian or German, keywords must also be provided in English.
5. **JEL codes:** maximum 5. <https://www.aeaweb.org/econlit/jelCodes.php?view=jel>

The abstract must not contain figures, tables or references.

In the case of presentations/poster in English, the entire abstract may be prepared in English.
