

Points system for the award of the national higher education scholarship at the Alexandre Lamfalussy Faculty of Economics

The national higher education scholarship is open to students who meet the conditions set out in the call for applications and have a grade point average of at least 4.00 in the semesters of the academic year in which the scholarship is awarded.

The professional (II.) and public, sporting, and other activities (III.) of the academic year of application are considered and must be documented.

I. Studies (ninety points in total)

1. Academic grade point average

*One point per hundredth from 4.00. Calculation procedure: (grade point average -4.00) *80*

A maximum of eighty points in total can be awarded for an academic grade point average.

2. Language exam

For all C1 general or professional complex language exams

six points

For all B2 professional complex language exams

five points

For all B2 general complex language exams

three points

Either the oral part or the written part for all B2 exams (if the student does not have a complex exam in this language)

one point

For all level B1 complex language exams

one point

In one language only the highest score counted.

A maximum of ten points can be awarded for a language exam.

II. Professional activities (thirty-six points in total)

1. Participant or place winner in the National Student Research Conference or National Higher Education Student Conference on Environmental Science as follows (points awarded only for the most outstanding performance):

a. National Student Research Conference 1st place

sixteen points

b. National Student Research Conference 2nd or 3rd place

fourteen points

c. Participant in the National Student Research Conference

eleven points

d. Place winner in the Faculty's Student Research Conference

ten points

e. Participant in the Faculty's Student Research Conference

eight points

2. Patent, innovation

max. eight points

3. National or international publication

max. eight points

4. Demonstrator, faculty work

max. six points

5. Work done in a professional dormitory group

max. eight points

6. Work done in an academic association

max. six points

7. Other professional activities

max. five points

8. Place winner or participant in a professional competition

max. six points

A maximum of thirty-six points can be awarded for professional activities.

III. Public, sporting, and other activities (ten points in total)

1. Student public engagement (maximum eight points in total, as follows):

a. The elected officer of the university's or faculty's Students' Union

six points

b. An elected officer of another student, non-professional, organization

max. three points

c. Outstanding work in the public life of university students

six points

d. Work in the public life of university students

max. four points

2. Other outstanding sporting activities, sporting achievement

max. three points

3. Other outstanding public, social or cultural activities

max. three points

A maximum of ten points can be awarded for public, sporting, and other activities.
